

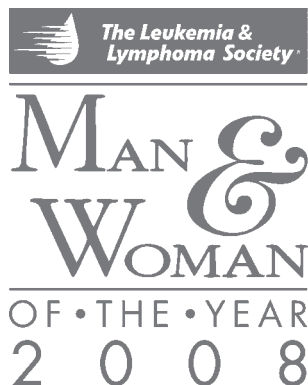
Some people show concern when they hear someone is battling an illness like blood cancer,

The mission of The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) is to cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and myeloma while improving the quality of life of patients and their families. Last year, LLS invested \$64 million in blood cancer research, nearly \$1 million in Michigan. Nearly 600 patients in Michigan receive financial assistance in excess of \$140,000 per year.
